

Survey Methodology

Period: December 02-14, 2020

Eligibility: Age 18+.

Response Rate: Approximately 37%

Margin of Error: Not More than $\pm 2.5\%$ at 95% confidence level at national-level results.

Sample size = 1,565

• Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the survey was conducted through Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (CATI). These interviews were conducted by a team of trained professionals with an attempt to closely match the demographic spread of Pakistan.

- A phone panel comprised of randomly selected 215,384 active mobile phone users was used as sampling frame to draw sample of adult residents in all four provinces. This Phone Panel was made through Face-to-Face data collection across all districts of Pakistan.
- In the first stage, allocation of primary sample units (PSU) was made by distributing sample to all the provinces as per their actual share. In the second stage, phone number were sorted in 73 districts, and then selection was be made using systematic Sampling with a Random Start (SSRS).

 The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.

Survey Method: Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (CATI)

Sample size= 1,565












Executive Summary



CORONAVIRUS REALITY Vs. INTERNATIONAL CONSPIRACY








WILLING TO TAKE A SHOT OF VACCINE

Q: Suppose that after some time vaccination for prevention from Coronavirus becomes available in Pakistan, will you be willing to take the vaccine for your family and yourself?



56% of the respondents said they are willing to take this vaccine, but 34% are reluctant and said they will not take any vaccine citing the following reasons.


- We don't believe the verification process of vaccine.

Q: Suppose that after some time vaccination for prevention from Coronavirus becomes available in Pakistan, will you be willing to take the vaccine for your family and yourself?



The major reason for this drop is, now people think that Coronavirus is not as hazardous as it was suppose to be.





PREFERRED VACCINE

Q: If Your are willing to take vaccine, which country's vaccine would you prefer?





Q: Regarding the Coronavirus pandemic, to what extent are you satisfied or dissatisfied of the handling of the situation by Prime Minister Imran Khan?









Q: Regarding the Coronavirus pandemic, to what extent are you satisfied or dissatisfied of the handling of the situation by Prime Minister Imran Khan?








IPOR asked a similar question in June


OPPOSITION PUBLIC GATHERINGS

Q: In the current pandemic situation of coronavirus, do you think the opposition should postpone their Public meetings and gatherings?






Majority 56% of the respondents said opposition should postpone their gathering and public meetings amid deadly second wave of COVID-19 pandemic.
