
## **Executive Summary**

- Institute for Public Opinion Research (IPOR) conducted national survey on the fact that how many percentage of Pakistanis are **willingness to immigrate abroad**.
- The survey report is based on the opinions of 1,197 respondents who were interviewed from September 5-15, 2023. Majority (75%) of the respondents were under the age of 40, in which respondents between the age of 18 and 25 made up 25% of the total and 26-40 were 50% while, those between 41 and 50 made up 18%, and those above 50 were 07% of the total. Error Margin +/-2-3 percent, Confidence Level will be 95 percent for national results.

Following are some of the important findings of this poll.

- On the question about if you get a chance to go abroad, 38% of respondents said that "Yes" they want to go abroad. While 45% said "No" they don't want to go abroad.
- I4% of respondents informed that they preferred to go KSA. While 9% said Dubai, followed by 4% UK & 3% Canada.



# Survey Methodology

Period :	September 05-15, 2023	
Eligibility :	Age 18+.	
Response Rate :	Approximately 39%	
Margin of Error :	Not More than $\pm 2-3\%$ at 95% confidence level at national-level results.	
Sample size	= 1,197	Com


- The survey was conducted through Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (CATI). These interviews were conducted by a team of trained professionals with an attempt to closely match the demographic spread of Pakistan.
- A phone panel comprised of randomly selected 241,253 active mobile phone users was used as sampling frame to draw sample of adult residents in all four provinces. This Phone Panel was made through Face-to-Face data collection across all districts of Pakistan.
- In the first stage, allocation of primary sample units (PSU) was made by distributing sample to all the provinces as per their actual share. In the second stage, phone number were sorted in 55 districts, and then selection was be made using systematic Sampling with a Random Start (SSRS).
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies.
- Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.

Survey Method: Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (CATI)

Sample size= 1,197



#### Gender





#### Q: If you get a chance to go abroad, would you like to go abroad?




On the question about if you get a chance to go abroad, 38% of respondents said that "Yes" they want to go abroad. While 45% said "No" they don't want to go abroad.

#### Q: If you want to go abroad, which country would you like to prefer?






Q: Do you think that the current situation in Pakistan will improve in the next five years?

41% said there will be no change in the current situation of Pakistan.


