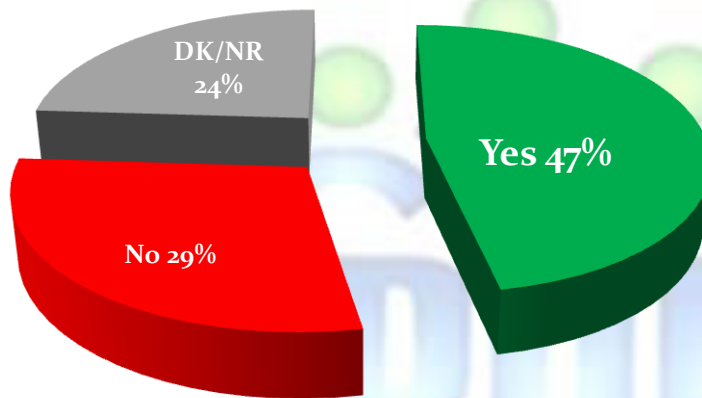


According to a survey carried out by Institute for Public Opinion Research (IPOR). **“47% of the respondents said Pakistan should send its military troops to Saudi Arabia to help in crises of Yemen”**

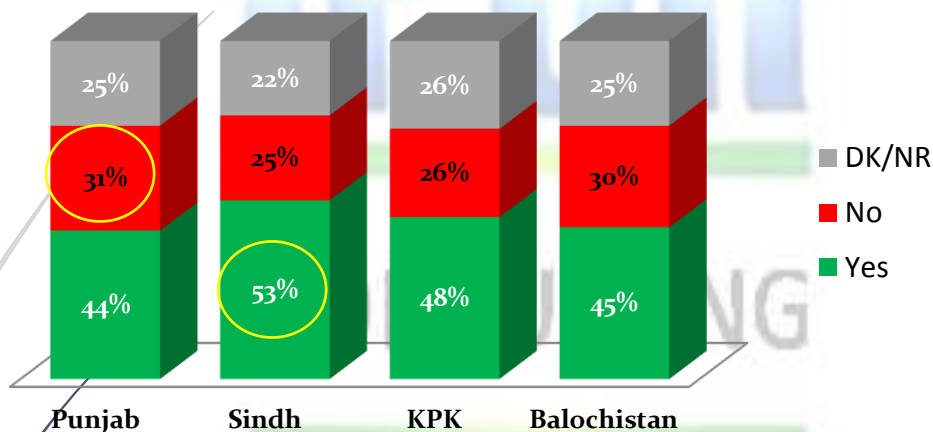
A National representative sample of men and women across Pakistan was asked” Should Pakistan send its military troops to Yemen to help out Saudi Arabia” 47% of the respondent said **“Yes”**, 29% said **“No”** rest of the 24% percentage didn’t answer this question.

Most of the support to send the troops comes from province of Sindh where 53% of the respondents favored it, whereas a sizeable 31% respondents of Punjab were totally against sending the troops to Saudi Arabia.

Provincial Breakdown



The interviews were conducted over telephone Institute for Public Opinion Research (IPOR) among a sample of 2,002 men and women with urban and rural division of all four province (Punjab, Sindh, KPK, Balochistan). The margin of error is estimated to be approximately $\pm 3\%$ at 95% confidence level. Time period of the study was April 5-9th, 2015
