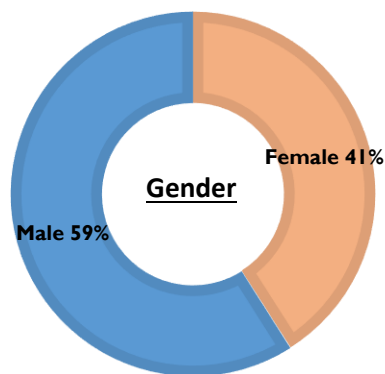
## Public Opinion Poll

### Methodology:

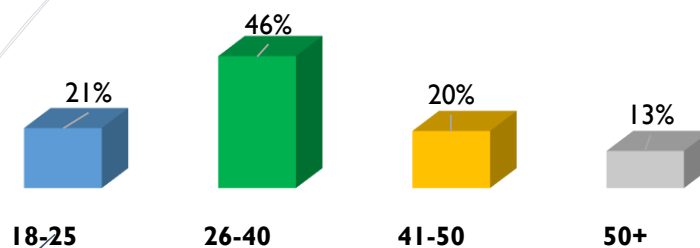
Institute for Public Opinion Research (IPOR) carried out a constituency survey of NA-04 Peshawar. The survey was conducted among the scientifically selected sample of 1313 voters of the constituency at 132 polling stations. The sample was collected at each polling station with 10 respondents. Field work was conducted face to face. The time period of the survey was October 16-19, 2017.

### Demographics of Survey:

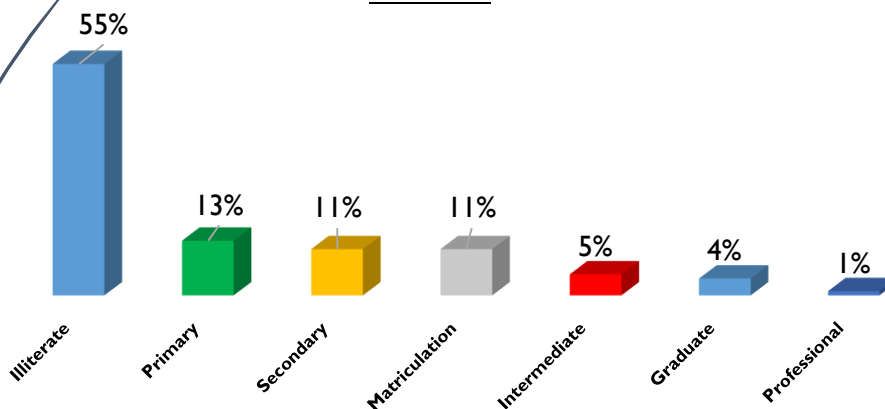
Followings were the demographics of the survey: 59% male and 41% of female respondents participated in the study. As figure shows majority 46% of respondent's form age group of 26-40, 21% from 18-25, 20% from 41-50 and remaining 13% from age bracket of 50 & above.

Education



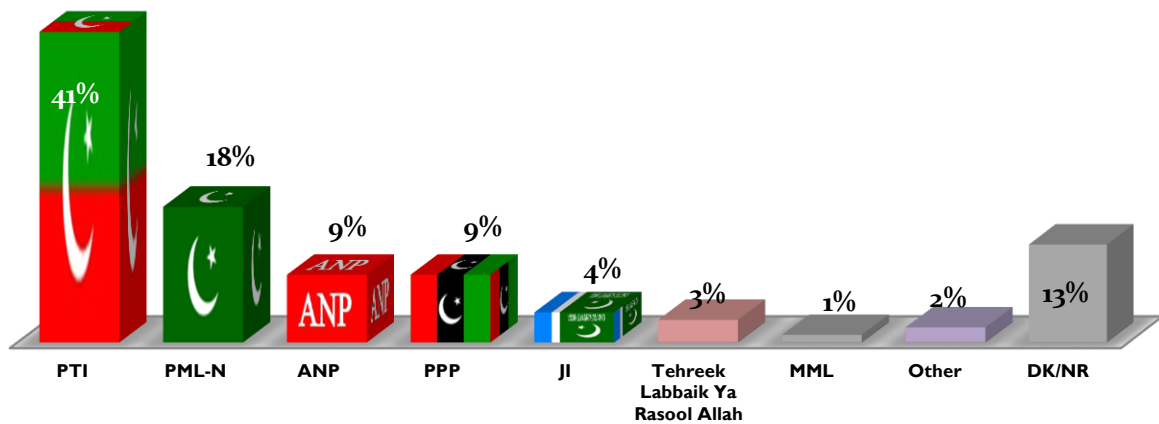
### Party ratings:

9% said **ANP** & **PPP** respectively, 4% said **JI** & 13%

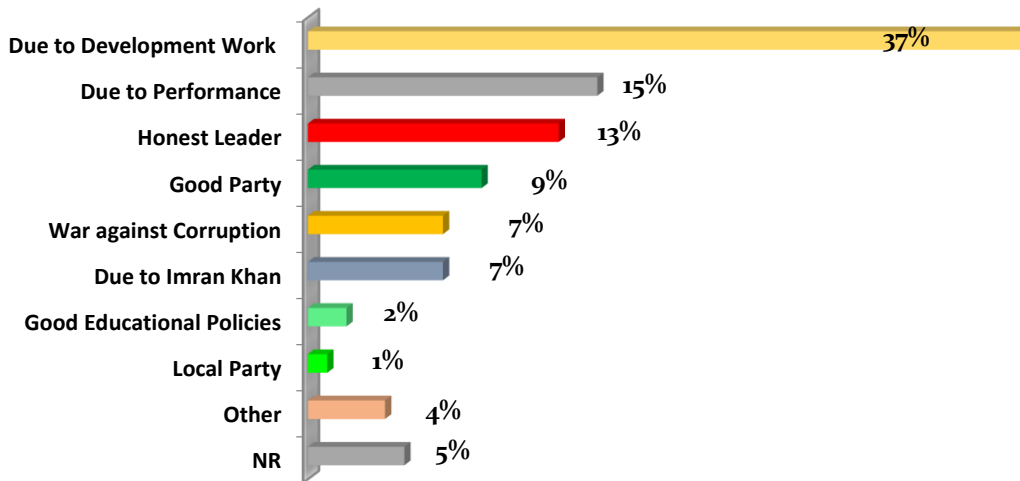

### In upcoming by-elections of your constituency which political party would you like to vote for?

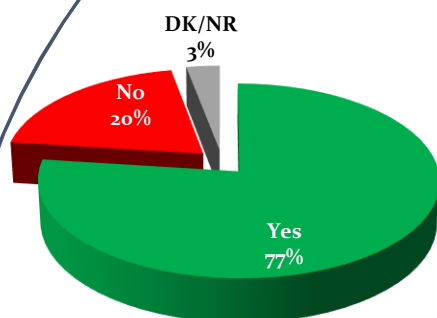


PTI respondents were further asked why would you vote for this party.

### What is the reason behind voting this party?

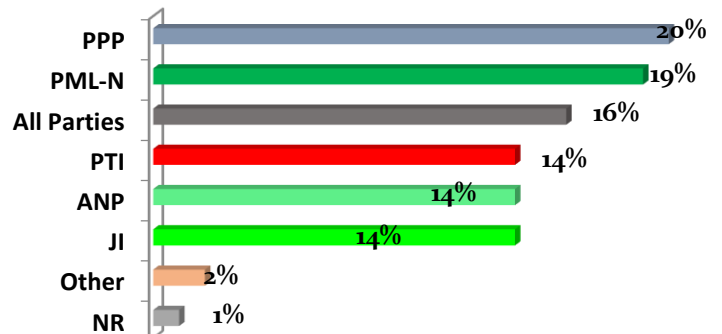


### Have any political party ever contacted you for vote?



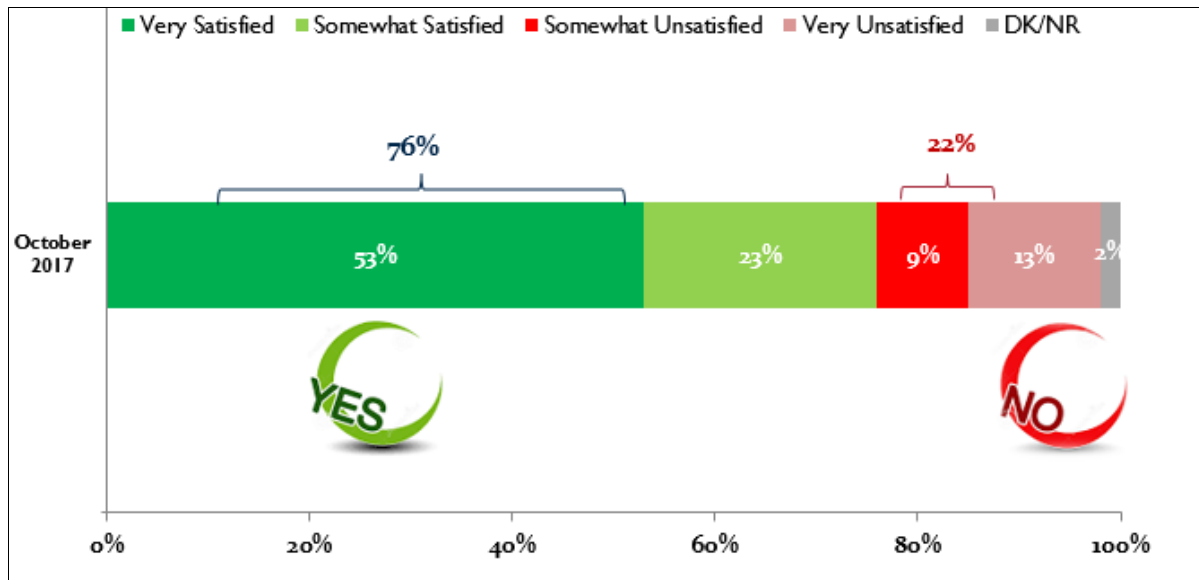
If Yes, which political party have contacted you?

Majority 76% respondents were satisfied with the performance of provincial PTI government.

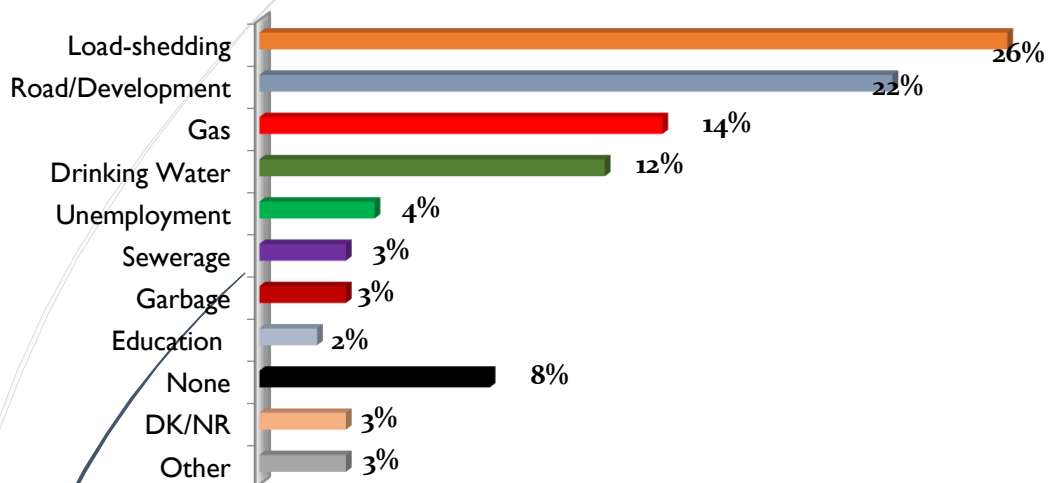
**Are you satisfied with the development work of PTI provincial government?**
