

### **Executive Summary**

#### **Background:**

• The Institute for Public Opinion Research (IPOR) conducted a quantitative survey in Punjab targeting the adult population (age 18 and above) of Punjab to gather public opinion on the 100-day performance of Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz Sharif. Maryam Nawaz Sharif has made history by becoming the first female to be elected as Chief Minister of Punjab.

### **Main Findings:**

- An over-all majority of **55%** of the respondents expressed **satisfaction** with the performance of the Punjab government, in the **Urban/Rural split,** it has been observed the dis-satisfaction level is higher in Rural Areas 42% compared to Urban Areas with 28%.
- ➤ Out of 35% who were not satisfied at-all with the last 3-month performance of CM, 51% of respondents believe that the government will never be able to improve the situation, regardless of the time given. And 19% of respondents are willing to give the government as much time as needed to improve the situation.
- ➤ 60% of respondents believe Maryam Nawaz's popularity has increased over the last three months.
- > 53% of respondents believe the government's steps have been effective in reducing prices of various commodities. A decrease in the price of **Roti** is the most favored project, with 44% of respondents considering it the best initiative. Following this project are the Solar Panel Program (11%) and the 200 Clinic on Wheels initiative (11%).




#### **Conclusion:**

Maryam Nawaz leadership in Punjab is highly regarded, with strong public approval of her **performance** and **initiatives**. While there is significant support for her efforts in **reducing Commodity prices** and specific projects like the **Bread price reduction**, as compared to other initiatives. However, her approval ratings in rural areas (48%) are not as good as in urban areas (62%).







**Insight:** Dis-satisfaction level is higher in Rural Areas **42**% compared to Urban Areas with **28**%. So, there is room for improvement for CM to increase favorability in Rural areas.

Insight: Out off that 35% who were not satisfied at-all with the last 3-month performance of CM, **51%** of respondents believe that the government will never be able to improve the situation, regardless of the time given. And **19% of respondents** are willing to give the government as much time as needed to **improve the situation**.




Q:What do you think the steps taken by the Pakistan Muslim League-N government have been effective in reducing prices of various commodities?






Insight: A significant majority, 60% of respondents, believe that the popularity of Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz has increased in the last three months.





## **Survey Demographic**


The IPOR survey respondents consisted of 65% males and 35% females. Geographically, 60% were from rural areas and 40% from urban areas. In terms of age distribution, 43% were between 18 and 35 years old, 48% were between 36 and 50 years old, and 9% were above 51 years old. 16% are illiterate, 12% have completed primary education, 15% have completed secondary education, 28% have completed matriculation, 14% have completed intermediate education, 10% are graduates, and 5% have completed a master's degree.





### Urban /Rural

# Survey Methodology

**May 29-12 June**, 2024

Eligibility: Age **18**+.

Response Rate: Approximately 45%

Margin of Error: Not More than  $\pm 3-4\%$  at 95% confidence level at Province-level results.

Sample size = 2010

- The survey was conducted through Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (**CATI**). These interviews were conducted by a team of trained professionals with an attempt to closely match the demographic spread of Pakistan.
- A phone panel comprised of randomly selected 268,000 active mobile phone users was used as sampling frame to draw sample of adult residents in Punjab. This Phone Panel was made through Face-to-Face data collection across all districts of Punjab. Total number of districts in Punjab are 36 and we took data from all the districts of Punjab
- In the first stage, allocation of primary sample units (PSU) was made by distributing sample to all the provinces as per their actual share. In the second stage, phone number were sorted in 36 districts, and then selection was be made using Systematic Sampling with a Random Start (SSRS).
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies.
