PUNJAB SPEAKS Public Verdict on One Year of Governance (Feb.2024- Feb.2025)





Findings from a Public Opinion Poll of Punjab February 3-18, 2025

Detailed Methodology

Period :	February 3- 18, 2025
Survey Type :	In-person, in-home interviews.
Eligibility :	Age 18+. The survey is a representative sample of voting-age residents of Punjab.
Total Respondents :	n = 6,600
Response Rate :	Approximately 71% (Based on RR Formula developed by American Research Association)
Overall Margin of Error : $\pm 2-3\%$ at the mid-range with a confidence level of 95%.	

- A multi-stage probability sample was used. In the first stage, the sample was stratified into all 36 Districts of Punjab. In the second stage, the sample was further stratified into Tehsils within each district, and it was divided into rural and urban categories. In the third stage, from each Tehsil it was further stratified by union councils/ Blocks/ Villages.
- The Probability-Proportional-to-Size (PPS) method was used to select Primary Sample Units (PSUs). Households within each PSU were selected through "Random walk method". By which starting point was determined and by following the Right Hand Rule (RHR) pattern every *n*th household were selected for interviews.
- The Kish Grid was used to select respondents 18 years and older within these randomly selected household.
- The data was collected by using CAPI (Computer Assisted Personal Interview) technique.




- Interview teams were comprised of both males and females; the female respondents were interviewed by female interviewers and male respondents by male interviewers.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.


Sample Distribution




Survey Demographics


Urban /Rural






Age Group















How would you evaluate the performance of the following sectors in Punjab over the past one-year?










In your opinion, how do you Rate the Performance of Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz compared to the other three Chief Ministers?






OPINION RESEARCH In which key sectors has Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz demonstrated the strongest performance? (Top Eight) (Open-Ended)








In your Opinion which one sector require attention and improvement from the Chief Minster Maryam Nawaz immediately?(Open-Ended) (Top Ten)








If you think, Yes, It has improved in what way it has improved?


